Welcome all players, parents, officials, coaches, managers, spectators and fans to the first Auckland Ice Hockey newsletter for 2009.

President's Message

What a great summer we have had, and the ice hockey season is just around the corner. This Pre-season newsletter will tell you what to expect so read the information carefully and mark your diary with the important dates.

The Ice Blacks will be playing 2 games against HC Storm, a team from Vassa in Finland, at Botany in March. Look for details later in this newsletter.

The Ice Blacks will then be competing at the IIHF World Championships Div III in Dunedin, 10 - 16 April. You can follow their progress on www.iihf.com/channels0809/wm-iii They play Luxembourg, Turkey, Greece, Mongolia and Ireland. You might like to consider going down to support their campaign to win Gold and promotion back up to Div II. More information is available on www.nzicehockey.co.nz/iihfchampstitle.html

There will be a number of changes for the 2009 season. Premier hockey will start late February and run through to the end of May. This will allow an extended National league competition to run uninterrupted from June to early September.

Peewees and Juniors will continue to play on Monday evenings but Midgets will play on Tuesday evenings. The Peewee Rep team will play in the Midget League on Tuesday nights and the Midget Rep Team will play in the Junior League on Monday nights.

National Champs are being held in Auckland. Senior Non Check and Women 28 – 30 August. Juniors, Midgets and Peewees 10 – 13 September.

This means that all **Peewee, Midget & Junior** players need to pay registration and a portion of the ice time costs **NO LATER than 16th March**, and the balance **NO LATER than 31st May**.

NOTE: Parents join as Parent/Guardian members with the registration of a Peewee, Midget or Junior player for FREE (at the time of registration).

SNC and Premier players also need to pay registration and the first portion of the ice time **NO LATER than 8th March**. Your League Directors will advise you of the payment schedule for the balance soon after that. It's very important that Auckland Ice Hockey have all players paid up by the above dates, as we need to have sufficient funds to pay Paradise for the ice time we use.

Peewee, Midget and Junior Leagues

Welcome to the 2009 Season

Well, we are going to start this year with a hiss and a roar!!!
We have some large projected numbers for the Midget and Junior Leagues this season.
As a result of these numbers we need to make some changes.

Peeweess will remain the same as last year with a 4 team competition.
For **Midgets and Juniors** we will be running a 6 team competition in each of the leagues.
The 6 teams will consist of 5 teams, with the 6th team being the Peewee and Midget Representative teams.
In order to make a 5th team in the league we may have to move a few players out of their existing teams. If we have to do this we will contact the effected players before we make those changes.

Due to these changes we are having to shift game times and days. The format will be 2 games at one rink and 1 game at the other rink, with the second game alternating each week between rinks. This means that all 6 teams will play one game each week and there will be no byes.

To accommodate these extra games we have shifted Midgets game night to Tuesdays.
Peewee and Midget trainings remain on Sunday mornings.
Juniors will still train on Tuesday but they will only train every other week, the reduction in Junior fees reflects this change.

Adding the Peewee and Midget Reps into the leagues allows them to play many more games together before they face their foes at the Nationals.

Junior Reps will be playing regular games against senior teams on a Thursday evening at Botany.

Peewee, Midget and Junior Grade Player Evaluations

No Charge for Evaluations

All players intending to participate in Peewee, Midget and Junior grades need to attend the evaluation sessions to be placed in a team. Evaluation sessions are **FREE**.

These are compulsory for **ALL** Peewee, Midget and Junior players. We use this information to help us put teams together for the new season.

On your arrival at the rink please report to the League Directors, they will give you a number for your helmet. This will speed up the evaluations.

If you cannot make the evaluation session at your rink base PLEASE attend the evaluations at the other rink.

Also note that you need only attend ONE evaluation session.

Due to changes in Peewee, Midget and Junior regular season format we are running Rep Team Trials this year. These trials are for the respective age group Rep Team Development Squad.

The Rep Team that plays each week will be chosen from the pool of Development Squad players and will vary from week to week, at the discretion of the Rep Coaches.

The final Representative teams will be announced later in the season.

It will be compulsory for all 2009 NZIHL players to also play in the Auckland Premier league to be eligible for NZIHL selection. (The only exception to this rule - it is not compulsory for the 2009 Ice Blacks to play in the Auckland Premier League but they are always welcome).

Senior Non Check 2009

We are less than a couple of weeks away from the start of our 2009 SNC season and this year is shaping up to be even better than last year.

Last year, we moved to a 3 tier system which sought to increase the level of competition by grouping our 18 teams into three different tiers based on the relative skills of the teams.

Based on the feedback we have received this shift has been very successful. We are hoping to build on that success this year.

The season will run from the last weekend in February to mid-October. Pre-season will see each team getting 3 games which will allow managers to review their teams and for us to ensure that each team is in the right tier for them. Regular season begins around Easter running until about mid-October (every team will get 20 regular season games). All SNC players are required to be members of the AIHA (\$100) and the ice fees associated with playing this year will depend on the number of players your team has and how many trainings your team decides to have.

Like last year, there is a burning need for more referees and the SNC represents the biggest group of potential volunteers in Auckland hockey. We really need to step up and get some people involved in refereeing or we are going to be hard pressed to find enough referees to manage our season. Its good exercise, great skating practice, an opportunity to get a better understanding of the rules, you get paid (not heaps, but still enough to buy beer with), and most of all it will be good for our league. AIHA will be purchasing referee equipment – this means that you can try being a referee without having to fork out cash for kit – what have you got to lose? If you are interested, send your details to snchockey@gmail.com

In light of our referee shortage, we will again be cracking down quite heavily on the 'referee abuse'. Only the managers and the captains of a team should be talking to the refs and in a way that is constructive as opposed to abusive. Feel free to have a good solid whinge with the boys over a beer after the game but let's leave it at that.

Officials Needed for 2009

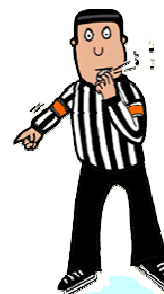
A big thanks to all the officials for their efforts last year and we hope to see many back again this year for the 2009 season.

2009 National Championships

Auckland will be hosting the 2009 National Championships for all grades (except Premiers). These will be held 28-30 August for Senior Non-Check and Women and 10-13 September for Peewees, Midgets and Juniors.

For more details check back in later newsletters or on www.aiha.org.nz closer to the time.

AIHA Team Selection Policy (except SNC)

Competitive hockey is about balanced teams and maximum enjoyment. Achieving 100% equality among all teams is improbable. There are so many variables – player interaction, coach's abilities, player's skills improving at different rates during the season to name a few.

However, for the benefit of the game and the players we must try. This means that for 2009 players will not necessarily be in the same teams or with the same coaches as in 2008.

The process for team selection will be:

1. Two evaluation sessions will be held for each age group – all players need to attend one of the 2 sessions.
2. Evaluators will be responsible to evaluate one particular skill for all players in each age group to maintain consistency.
3. Every player will be given a fair opportunity to demonstrate their ability in: Skating, Passing, Shooting & Puck Handling.
4. Evaluation results will remain confidential and won't be published.
5. Goaltenders will be evaluated specifically on goaltending skills.
6. The League Director and one coach from each team will meet to form teams. The aim is to form balanced teams, which will provide a balanced competition as far as possible.
