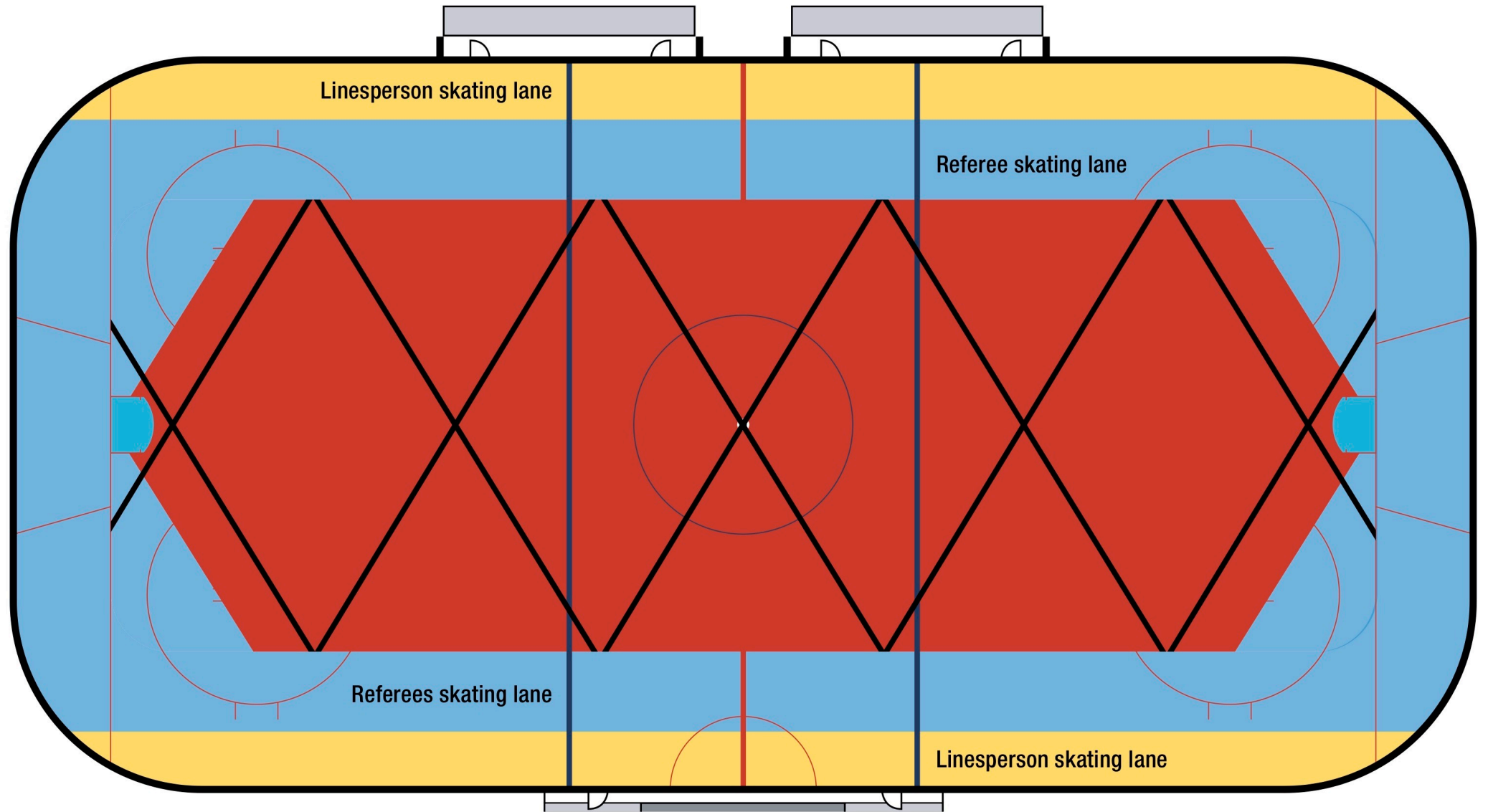
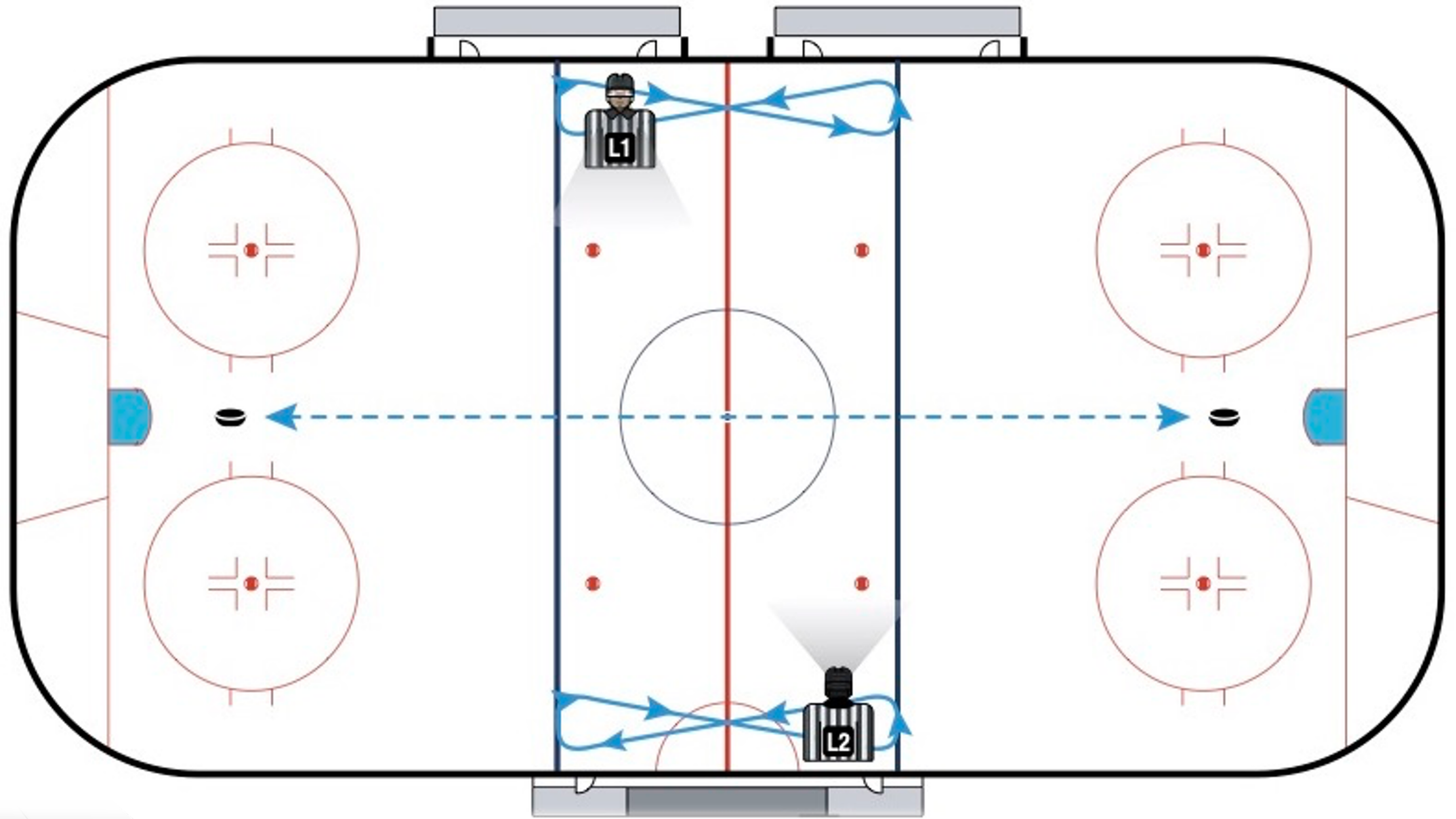
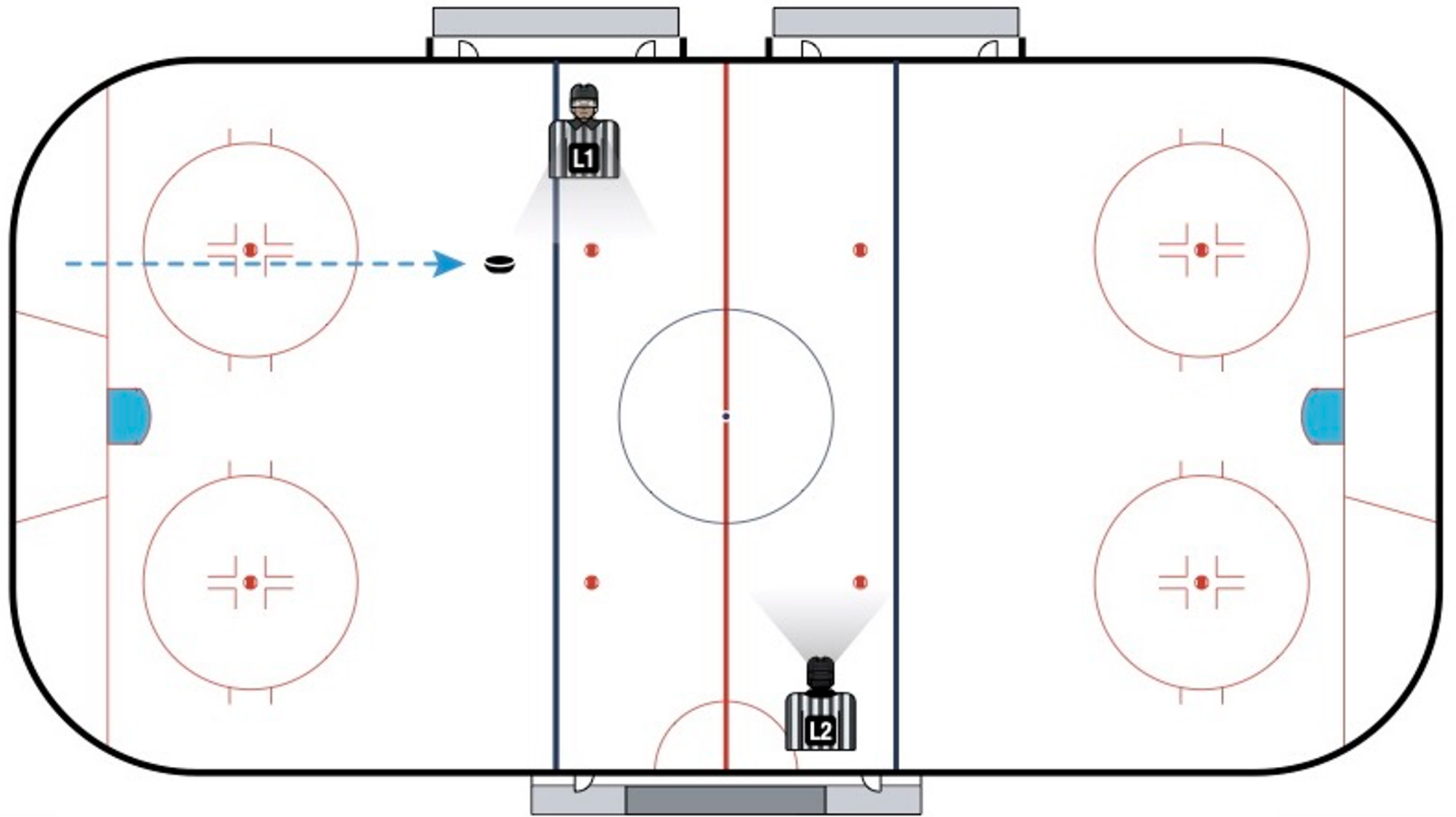

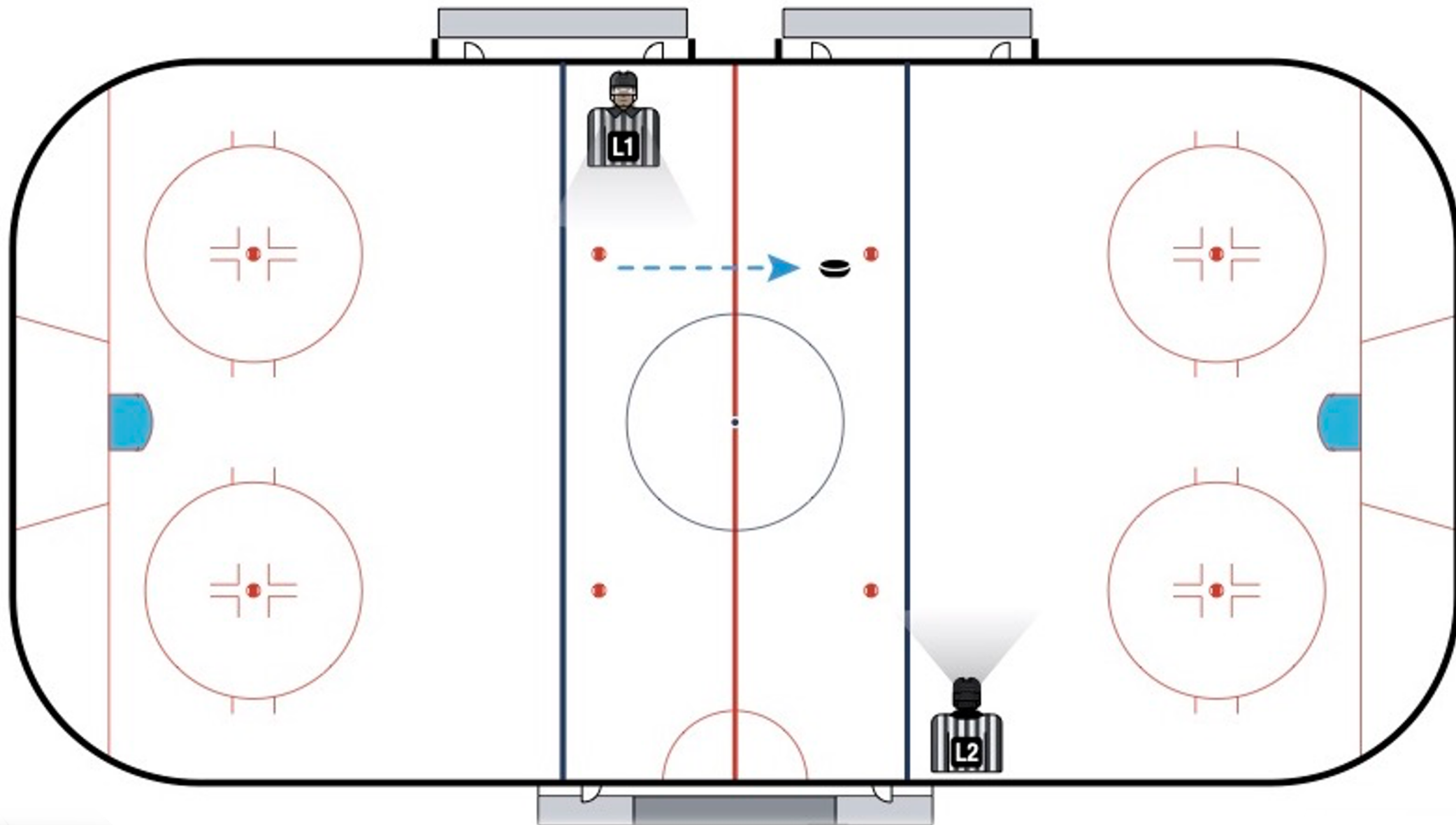
Positioning while play is in progress

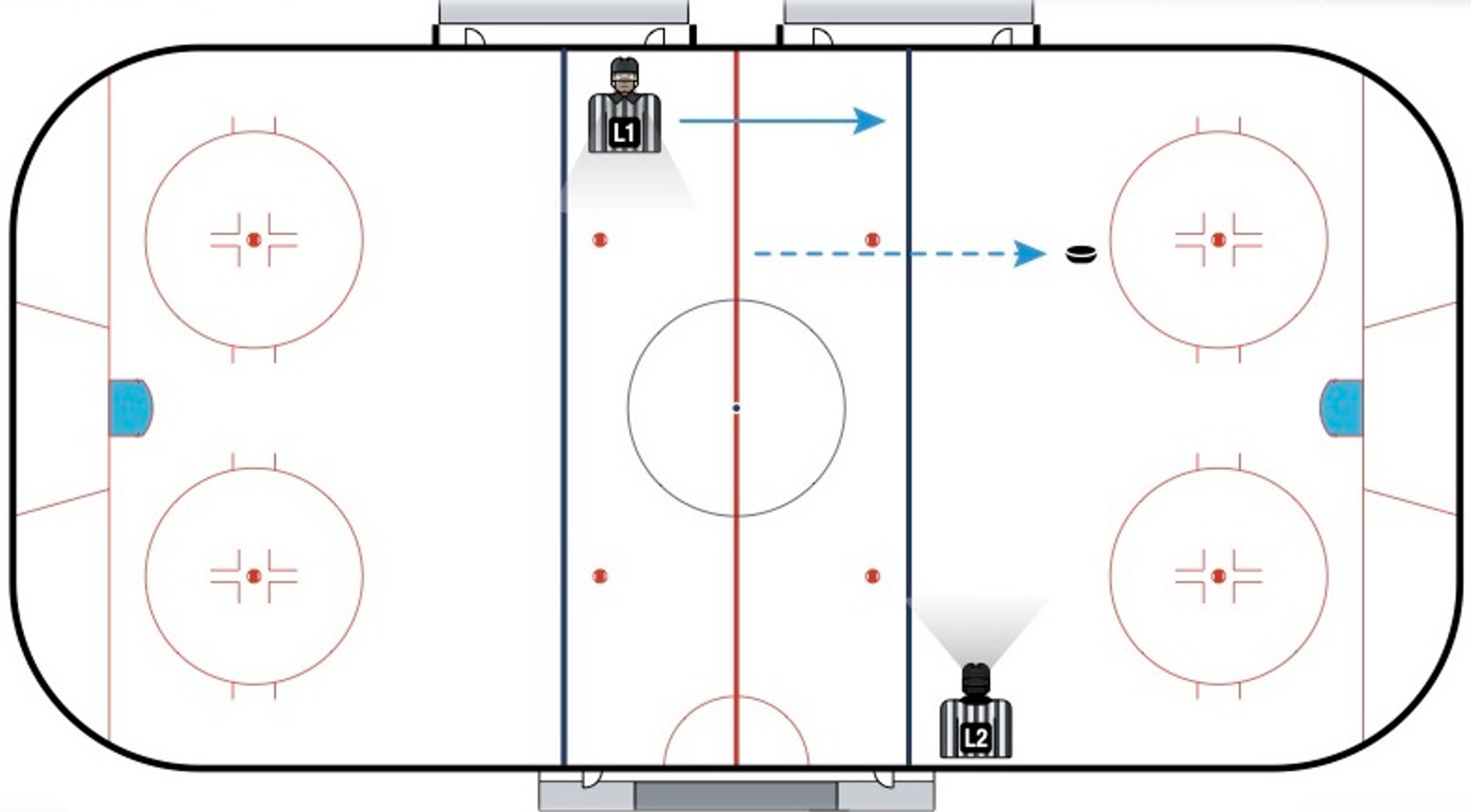
Positioning while play is in progress: defending team exiting zone

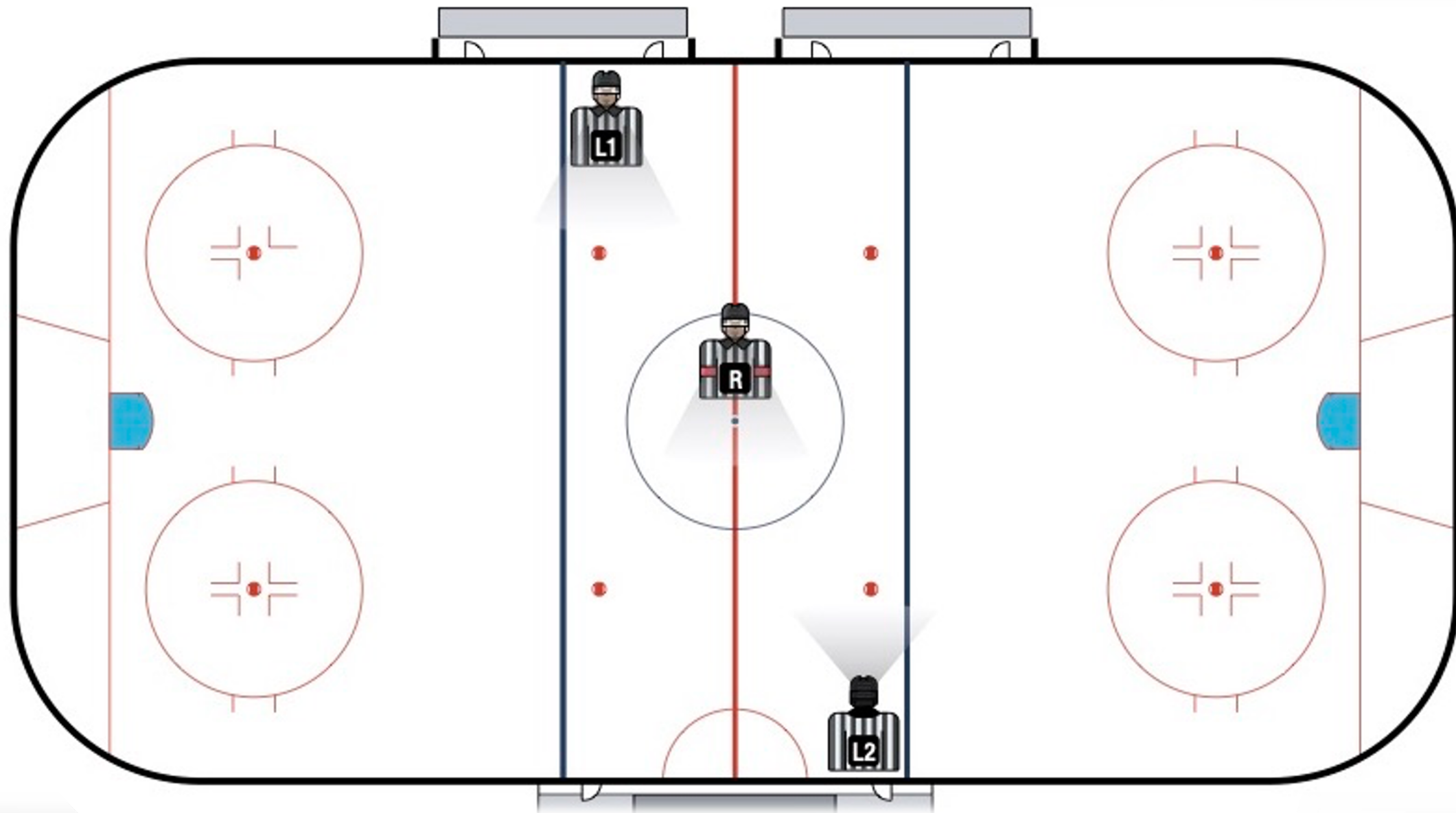
Positioning while play is in progress: transition in neutral zone

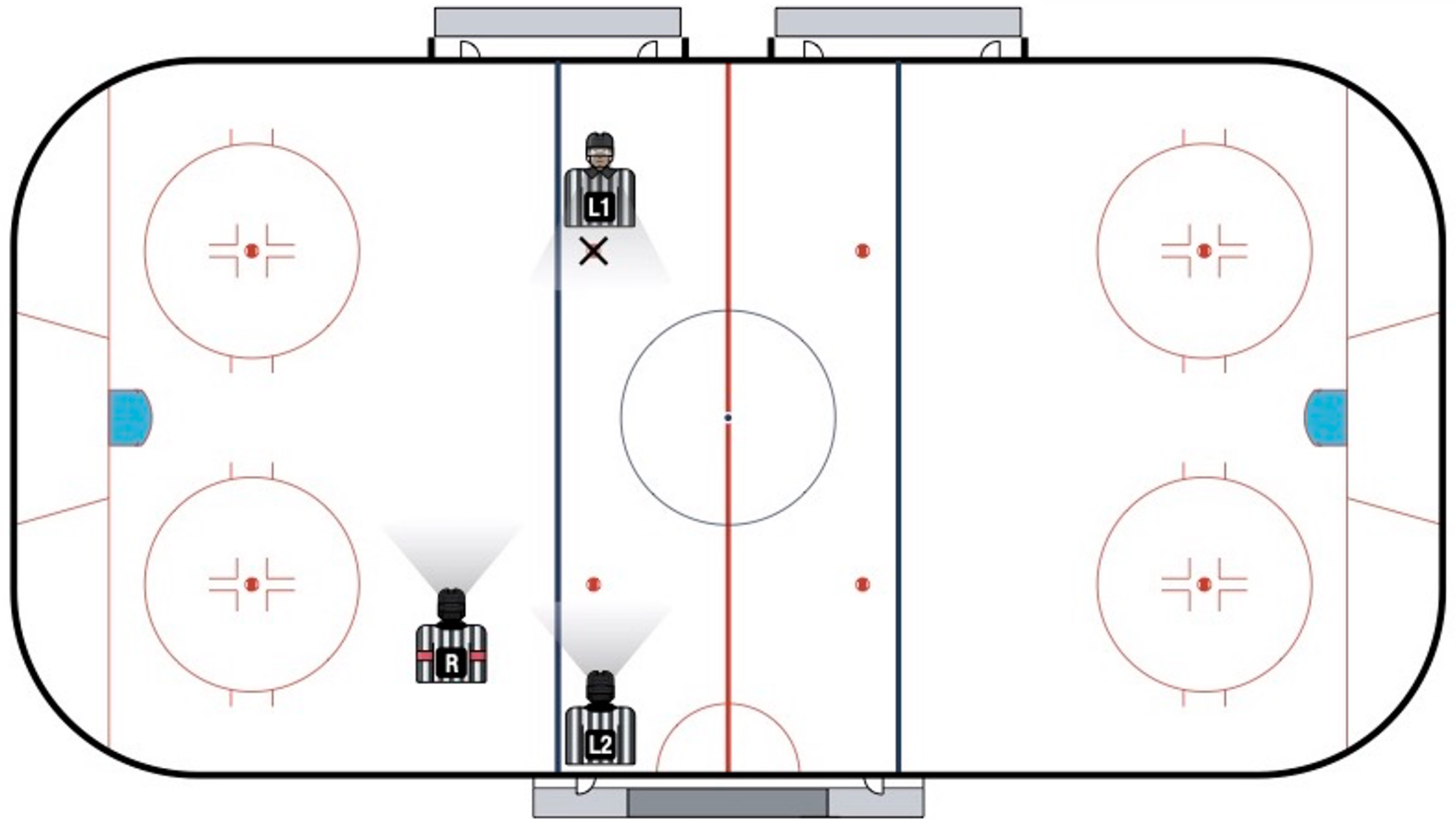
Positioning while play is in progress: entering attacking zone

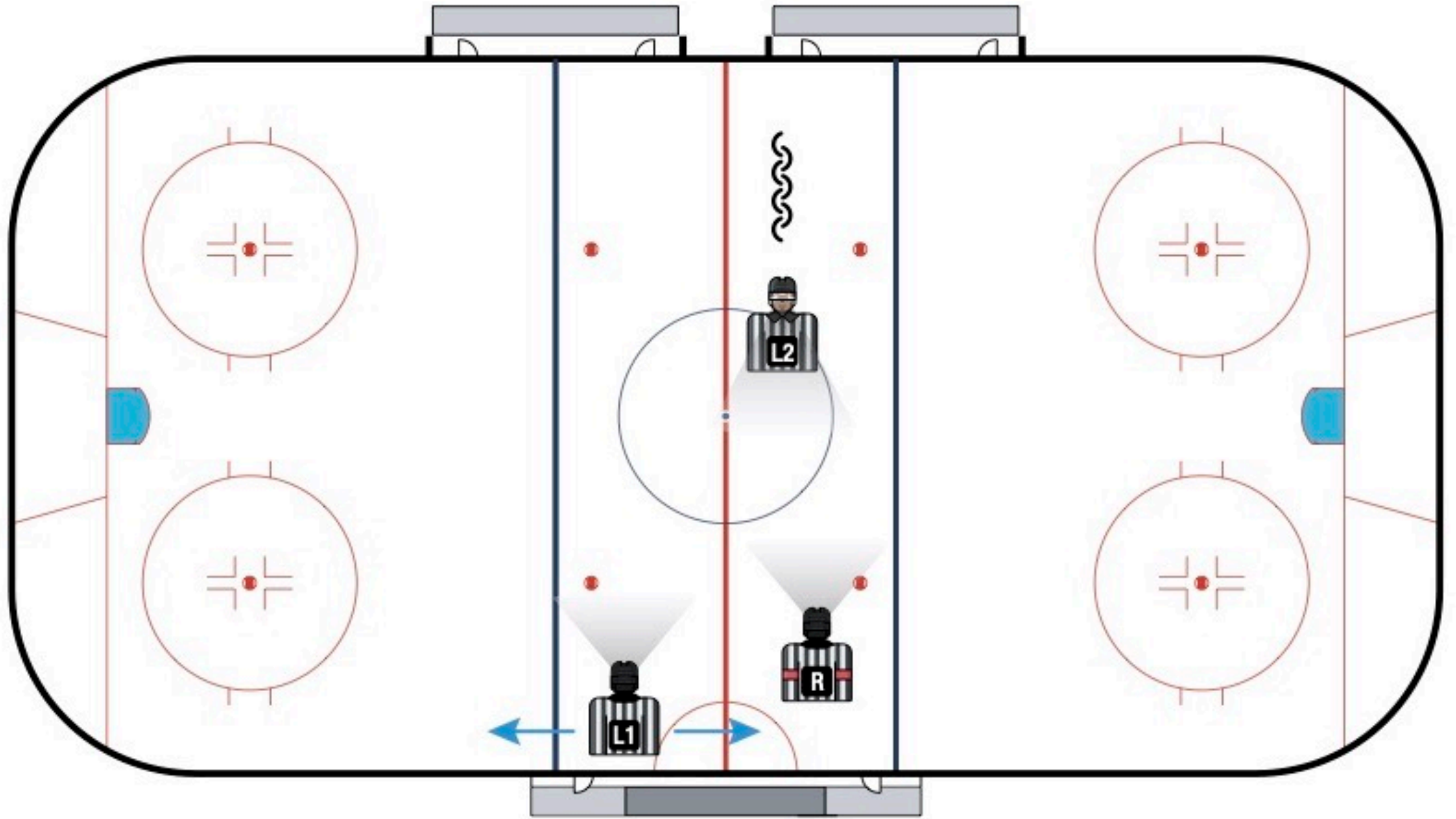
Positioning for Face-Off: Neutral zone, centre ice

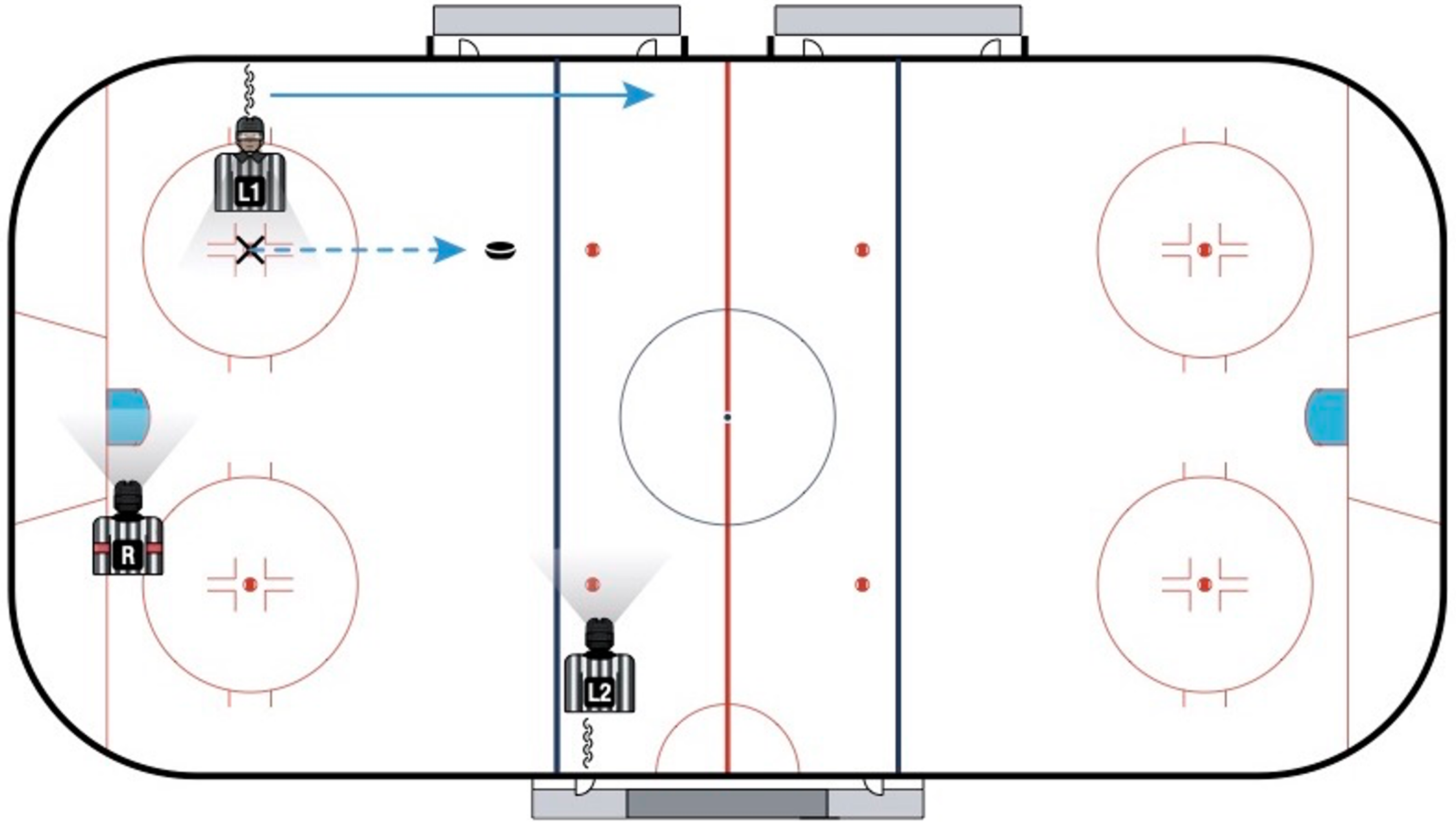
Positioning for Face-Off: Neutral zone, neutral zone dots

3.3. DESIGNATED BLUE LINE

To ensure consistency in the judgment of offside situations, the linespersons will be in charge of the majority of the decisions made at a designated blue line. This designated blue line should follow the pre-selected side for face-offs as described

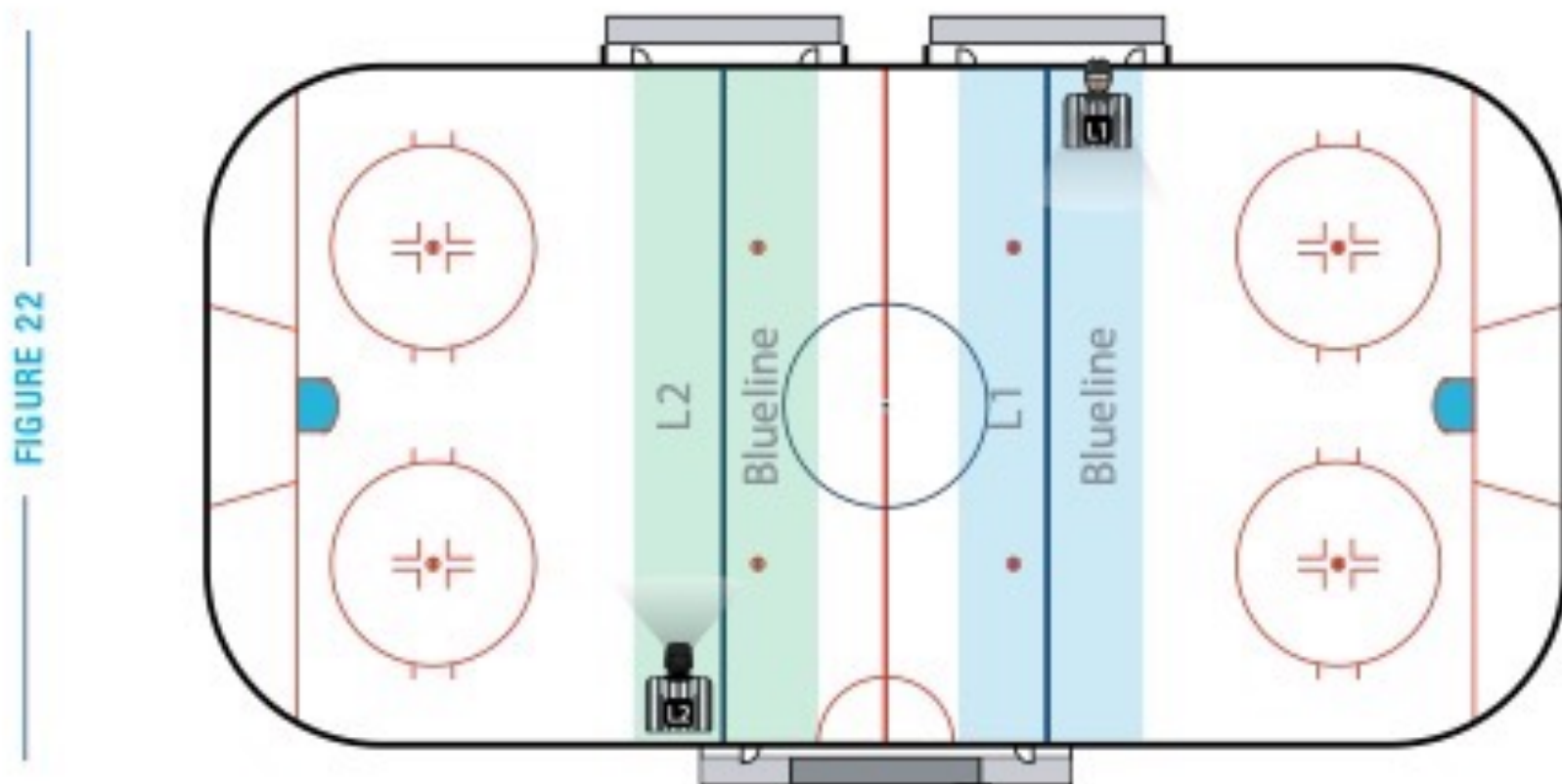
