

DUNEDIN CHALLENGE CUP TOURNAMENT RULES

1	Team enter each team must pay a deposit of \$100 by 31 January to confirm your teams spot, and remaining entry fees must be received by 28 February 2019
2	To register teams must name 9 players and 1 goalie minimum
3	All players must be turning 15 the year of the touranment or older (ie born in 2004 or earlier)
4	Players must be female.
5	Teams must field 7 players plus a goalie or a 5-0 forfeit will apply.
6	Players must have played at least 2 round robin games to play in the finals.
7	The tournament will run under the IIHF rulebook
8	Game format will be 3min warm-up, 3 x 14 min period (1 min breaks)
9	There will be a groom between each game
10	Games can end in a tie, however in semi/finals IIHF overtime rules will apply
11	2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw
12	If two teams are tied after the round robin the Head to Head game will decide, then the higher goal difference, then least penalty minutes.
13	If the game is within 2 goals or less with 2 minutes to play stop-time will be played
14	The tournament organisers reserve the right to reschedule any games if required
15	Any clarifications or disputes will be handled by Referee-in-Chief
16	The tournament organisers will have the final say in all matters.
17	Prizegiving and tournament lunch will be help upstairs at the conclusion of the final game
